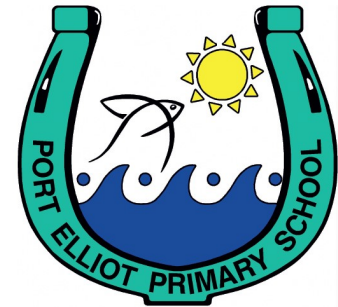

**UNIFORM POLICY**



**At Port Elliot Primary School we take pride in our appearance and acknowledge the importance of publicly displaying our school colours.**



## **Purpose**

The school asks parents to support the wearing of our school colors for the purpose of:
